



In such a situation you need union representation immediately. If the REDC calls with an allegation, contact your steward or a member of the Local Executive Committee BEFORE you talk to the REDC. We will make sure any investigations are thorough, and that allegations are handled appropriately. Some accusations can have sweeping effects on one's reputation and morale. It is important that you have support and assistance in dealing with these matters. We have worked with the REDC to resolve a number of cases in which faculty have been falsely accused. Remember, if the REDC contacts you, call us first!
