Sick Leave Buyout Offers

FULL TIME FACULTY HIRED BEFORE APRIL 1991

If you are one of the relatively few full time faculty hired before April 1991 still working, you are entitled to cash out accumulated sick days according to an agreed formula when you conclude your employment at Seneca.

As every year, you can expect the college to send you a formal offer to buy out your accumulated credits.

Generally, our advice is that unless you badly need the money, do not take this offer, as there are heavy tax consequences.

If you are considering accepting the offer you should consult a financial advisor.
